‘(12 a) The Commission’s Trade Policy Review – An Open, Sustainable and Assertive Trade Policy<sup>17</sup> – states that the European Green Deal is the EU’s new growth strategy that will be the driving force behind our competitiveness and will lead to a progressive but profound transformation of our economies, which in turn will have a strong bearing on trade patterns, while the EU’s vast network of bilateral trade agreements is an essential platform to engage with our partners on climate change and biodiversity and therefore demands the introduction of “mirror” measures, in line with WTO rules.
